The exceptions are newspapers, novels, academic journals, political and commercial treaties, statutes and legal documents, unpaginated or inconsistent prefaces, and other regular publications, which are detailed either in the body of the text or in the footnotes themselves. The second section contains full details of all the material mentioned in the text and a general bibliography of the uncited material employed for the writing of this book; it is not, however, intended as a full bibliography of the subject matter. All publications were issued in London unless otherwise stated.
